

### **DRESS CODE**

Maintaining a dress code for a school is a partnership between school and home. It is important for both parties to work together to ensure that all students dress neatly and appropriately for school. A dress code that stresses this shows that uniqueness and the pride we all have in our Catholic Schools.

At all times, clothing must reflect the values of Roncalli Catholic Schools. **The dress code is subject to** interpretation by the school principal and will be enforced at all times.

## Roncalli Middle School Campus Dress Code

- Collared shirts are acceptable with a small, no greater than a half dollar sized emblem or logo.
- No college or professional team apparel (unless announced by principal on special occasion days).
- Students may wear shirts that are scoop neck, V-neck, or a style that is not a traditional t-shirt style. Any shirt that is solid color, striped, or has a pattern of some type is acceptable, no words or sayings. No bare shoulders.
- Logos may not be larger than a fifty-cent piece.
- Roncalli or plain sweatshirts are acceptable for the dress code.
- No sweatshirts (of any type) are allowed on liturgy days. \*\*If a child is cold, student may wear fleece, a sweater or jacket if it is too cold in church.
- Hats, sunglasses, and bandanas are not allowed in school.
- Shoes: Gym/deck/flats/dress must be closed toe and heel required. Required to have all laces tied. High heels/wedges, sandals, flip-flops, Crocs, clogs and "wheelie" skates are not permitted.
- Socks, stockings, or peds must be worn at all times.
- No excessively tight or loose pants are to be worn. No underwear should be showing at any time.
- Unnaturally colored hair is not allowed.
- Shorts and capris season is May 1 through September 30 and/or at the discretion of the building principal.
- Non-traditional days may be announced:
  - Students may wear Roncalli or other sports' team apparel.
  - Extra jeans days will be announced.
  - Jeans days are only on Fridays. Sweatpants may be worn on jeans' days.
  - T-shirts, they may not advertise alcohol, tobacco, bands/musical groups nor should they have sarcastic or demeaning says on them.

## Girls:

- Skirts, dresses, and shorts must be fingertip length.
- Earrings: studs or small hoops allowed.
- Makeup should be used at a minimum.
- Leggings/jeggings may only be worn under a skirt, dress, and long tunics and non-tucked-in blouses.
- Leggings/jeggings worn with long sweaters are not permitted.
- No form fitting tops.

#### Boys:

- No earrings are allowed.
- Collared shirts or sweaters must be worn on liturgy days.

# Middle School Dress Code Violation Consequences

- **First Offense**: A parent will be contacted regarding the questionable piece of clothing. Article may not to be worn again.
- **Second Offense**: A parent will be contacted regarding the questionable piece of clothing and student will be required to change. (Clothing will be provided if new clothing is unable to be provided to student by family)
- **Third Offense**: A detention will be given for a dress code violation during the week. (Middle school students will lose ability to wear jeans on Friday).
